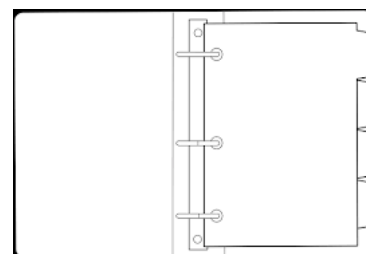
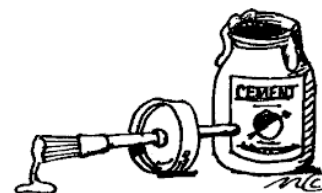
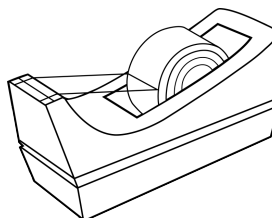


Room 10's Suggested Supply List

- 1- A tool for organization that works best for you. (1 inch binder/ accordion folder)
- 4- 3-hole punched folders
- 4 spirals- green, yellow, blue, and red
- Writing journal
- 1 graph paper spiral (must be wire bound or it will fall apart)
- 3 jars of rubber cement
- Ruler
- Scotch tape (2 rolls)
- 2 red & 2 green checking pens
- Sharpened Pencils
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- 4 highlighters (different colors)
- Pad of Post-It notes
- Clipboard (recommended, but not necessary)
- Flash Drive
- Earbud headphones *with* case to keep them in
- 1 inch binder with poly-cover to slide a cover in
(We will use this for our data binder)
- 5 tabbed dividers (To separate the sections of our data binder)
- Calculator (Recommended)
- 1 pack of white washcloths (We use these to wipe surfaces in our classroom daily!)



* We find that wire bound spiral notebooks work best and stand up to classroom use. Perforated paged and bound notebooks fall apart easily.

We use scrapbook paper for our 6th grade memory books and other projects.

It would be useful if you could donate some **scrapbook paper or brightly colored copy paper.**

It would also be extremely helpful if you could donate a box of **Kleenex** and a spray bottle of **“Mrs. Meyers multi-surface cleaner”** or any type of **spray cleaner that uses organic ingredients.**
